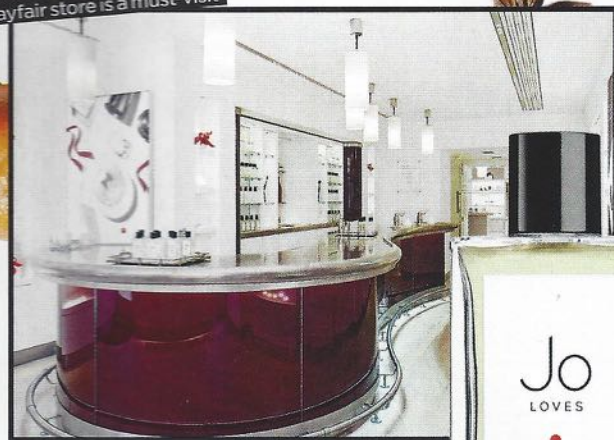




SHELF INTERESTED
