Make your Own greeting cards & gift wrap

- Materials:
- Potato - large & firm
 - paintbrush
 - charcoal pencil 2B/8
 - cutter
 - wire modeling tool
 - acrylic paint
 - raffia
 - cowrie shells
 - kraft paper & card stock (for the greeting card)

Step 1

- RESEARCH african PATTERNS
- SLICE the potato in 2 (with 1 potato we can make 2 stamps!)
- with a paper towel, dry the inside of the potato
- DRAW the pattern using the charcoal pencil 2B

Step 2

- cut out the pattern using the cutter
- use the wire modeling tool to remove the parts that should not appear on the stamp

Step 3

- Use the BRUSH to spread paint out over the stamp
- Stamp the PATTERN in an alternating & symmetrical fashion
- kraft paper for GIFT WRAP or card stock for GIFT CARDS
- Apply paint regularly!

Step 4

- GRAB several strands of raffia
- lie together the center of the knor using a separate strand
- * CUSTOMIZE with one or several cowrie shells attached using the raffia ...
